Contributions of all sizes make a large difference. For Example:

- ❖ **\$55** allows a trained advocate to accompany and support a victim during a medical exam, which could take from 2 to 6 hours to complete (4 hours estimated).
- ❖ **\$85** helps fund one hour of caring, compassionate counseling to a victim in our community.
- ❖ **\$255** teaches three classes of 20 students how to reduce the risk of sexual assault or bullying. (This includes materials)
- ❖ **\$500** supports a day of our 24-Hour Crisis, Information & Referral Line with advocates available for direct assistance.

If you would like to make a gift in honor of or in the memory of someone special, we will gladly send a notification of the gift.

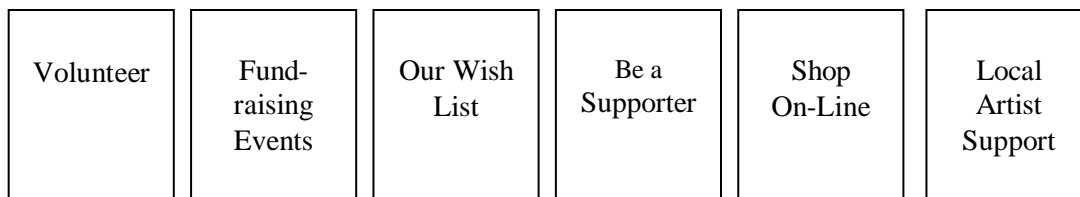
